THIS PATRON OPPORTUNITY AGREEMENT (the "Agreement"), is entered into by and between the Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association International (AFCEA) and Contracting Company (Patron), and shall become a contract upon execution. This Agreement shall confirm the details of Patron's patron of the DIA Science & Technology Industry Day (Event) being held May 24, 2017.

The individual executing this Contract represents and warrants that he/she is duly authorized to execute this binding contract on behalf of the Company.

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual undertakings and promises of the parties as set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

1. PATRON OPPORTUNITIES

1. AFCEA and Patron will develop and execute the patron in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement and as set forth in any Attachments and/or Exhibits to the Agreement. AFCEA and Patron agree they will perform their duties and responsibilities in a professional manner consistent, at all times, with industry standards and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

1.1. In consideration of the rights granted in the Agreement, Patron agrees to pay AFCEA a Patron Fee as defined on page one of this Agreement and a 50% deposit is to be included with this Agreement. For the Patron Fee, AFCEA agrees to provide Patron services as outlined in the Official Marketing Opportunity Prospectus.

2. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

In the event this Agreement is terminated for material breach of a party following the commencement of the Event and/or Patron activities, the parties agree nonetheless to cooperate to the extent necessary to avoid interruption of the Event. Such cooperation shall not be construed to waive any claim or defense a party may have.

3.3 In the event of cancellation by Patron, AFCEA shall determine an assessment covering the resale of the patron opportunity, prior services performed, and other damages related to cancellation, according to the following schedule:

Through January 24, 2017, 50% of total Patron fee.

After January 24, 2017, 100% of total Patron fee.

Any delay resulting from any of said causes shall extend performance accordingly or excuse performance, in whole or part, as may be reasonable under the circumstances.
