Several TechNet Augusta sessions will be approved to meet CompTIA and/or GIAC and may also support (ISC)², National Contract Management Association (NCMA), Project Management Institute (PMI), GAGAS, and Defense Acquisition Workforce continuing education and/or certification maintenance requirements.

- 1. - 2. How do I obtain the session documentation required for me to submit to CompTIA and/or GIAC?** Formal attendance documentation is a benefit of AFCEA membership. Participation in an event session qualifying for CompTIA CEUs and/or GIAC CPEs is required. Each GIAC certification remains valid for 4 years. Two years after certification the renewal process will begin, and individuals must maintain their credentials through Continuing Professional Education credits (CPEs). Credential holders must earn the minimum number of Continuing Professional Education credits (CPEs) annually during each year of the three-year certification cycle.
