- 2. How do I obtain the session documentation required for me to submit to CompTIA and/or GIAC?** Formal attendance documentation is a benefit of AFCEA membership. Participation in an event session qualifying for CompTIA CEUs and/or GIAC CPEs is required. On exiting the session, get your event badge scanned so that we can document your attendance. We will email documentation of your attendance by May 20, 2016.

Each GIAC certification remains valid for 4 years. Two years after certification the renewal process will begin, and individuals must maintain their credentials through Continuing Professional Education credits (CPEs). Credential holders must earn the minimum number of Continuing Professional Education credits (CPEs) annually during each year of the three-year certification cycle.
