#### Overview:

Cyber Law is the law that governs cyber space. Cyber space includes computers, networks, software, data, storage devices, the internet, emails, and other electronic devices such as cell phones and ATM Machines.

#### Overview:

The Department of Homeland Security describes cyber threat as a threat that involves an awareness of any identified efforts directed toward access to information, manipulation or impairment to the integrity, confidentiality, security or availability of data and application or government system without authority.

This session, presented at the Secret level, will address sources of cyber threats such as Bot network operators, business competitors, criminal groups, hackers, foreign military, phishers, and other threats that exist. The discussion will include types and techniques of cyber threats and challenges that face the military and other organizations and the impact on critical infrastructure.
