Continuing Education Frequently Asked Questions

Our Continuing Education (CE) program is designed to support certifications related to U.S. Federal Government requirements. Several WEST 2016 sessions will be approved to meet CompTIA and/or GIAC and may also support (ISC)², National Contract Management Association (NCMA), Project Management Institute (PMI), GAGAS, and Defense Acquisition Workforce continuing education and/or certification maintenance requirements.

- 1. How do I identify symposium sessions that are approved for CompTIA CEUs or GIAC CPEs?** Approved sessions are noted on the reverse side of this flyer, and will be included in the event show guide and mobile application, and on the web at <http://www.westconference.org/west16/Public/Content.aspx?ID=59196>
- 2. How do I obtain the session documentation required for me to submit to CompTIA and/or GIAC?** Formal attendance documentation is a benefit of AFCEA membership. Participation in an event session qualifying for CompTIA CEUs and/or GIAC CPEs is required. On exiting the session, get your event badge scanned so that we can document your attendance. We will email documentation of your attendance by March 19, 2016.

Each GIAC certification remains valid for 4 years. Two years after certification the renewal process will begin, and individuals must maintain their credentials through Continuing Professional Education credits (CPEs). Credential holders must earn the minimum number of Continuing Professional Education credits (CPEs) annually during each year of the three-year certification cycle.
